The Dry Comal Hike and Bike Trail winds through several different vegetation habitats: a savanna with prickly pear cacti and mesquite trees; an upland forest of old live oaks, Ashe juniper, cedar elm; and a riparian habitat including boxelder, hackberry and pecan trees.

FISCHER PARK

Stroll or run around the park on over two miles of greenway trails. Relax at the two fishing ponds, splash at the sprayground, enjoy the playgrounds or take in the dramatic views of New Braunfels from the 62-acre hill top park.

> DISTANCE: 2+ Miles

OLD HANCOCK TRAIL

1

Great trail for hiking and horseback riding. Trail follows the lake line and has very little elevation gain. The trail is a good spot for beginner bicyclists who want to try going off-road for the first time.

DISTANCE: 3.5 Mile

MADRONE TRAIL

2

Nice and rocky 7.6 mile trail that winds it's way through a peninsula on Canyon Lake. This is a popular mountain biking trail as there are lot of rocky challenges. Cool off in the lake after a hike or ride. Park fee may apply.

> **DISTANCE:** 7.6 Miles
